Omnipotent Bab3

The concept of God or His incarnation or the concept of a prophet, who is the representative of God is common to all the religions of the world. All religions also attribute the virtues of kindness, benevolence, mercifulness etc. to God. It is universally accepted that God is all powerful and that the whole of this universe moves according to the directions of God. The devotees have a very strong belief that in their difficulties the God comes to their help andlifts them out of the pit of their difficulties. The devotees all over the world, also believe that God is present everywhere and that He sees and knows everything. All these virtues and qualities have been briefly summarised in three attributes of God viz. omnipresent, omnipotent and omniscient.

Though different religions have sprung up at different places in the world and at different times, still they have retained this common factor of the concept of God, who is having certain common qualities. Why is it so? For answering this question we will have to look to the history of the mankind since its inception. The scientists all over the world are not yet sure about the exact time when man was born in this world. They always speak about some lacs of years as the date of the of mankind in birth this world and whenever a new fossil is unearthed the birth of man is pushed back by a few lac years ! There are diverse opinions about the birth of man. According to Darwin's theory of evolution, man steadily evolved from different animals by a continuous process, which was going

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on for thousands of years. Some other scientists do not agree with Darwin and they say that man was born only as a man and that he did not evolve. Anyway we will leave these theories and research to scientists and research scholars and consider only the undisputable fact which is relevant to our context and that fact is this that the aboriginal man was staying first in the caves in prehistoric days.

When mankind was thus thriving in the caves it was looking at nature with great wonder and awe. At some stage man witnessed a great thunder storm in the sky. He saw the sparkling streaks of lightening in the sky and the dazzling splendour that filled the sky. Sometimes this electricity came and fell on some tree and reduced it to charcoal. How much fear-stricken the pramitive man must have become at this sight? At other time he must have seen the rain pouring from the skies and surging the rivers nearby quite abnormally. The rivers must have uprooted huge trees by their gushing currents and they must have carried them with their water, which must have overflowed their banks and flooded large areas, creating a sort of a sea all around them. Some time the primitive man must have been aroused by loud noise and hot ashes and tire rising from the mouth of a volcano. This fire coming out from the peak of a mountain all of a sudden must no doubt have made the primitive man curious; but not knowing the real cause of the volcanic eruption, he must have only looked at it with fear and he must have only attempted to save himself from the fire, the lava and hot ashes and other material that must have gushed out of the volcano. A storm in the sea must have similarly frightened the primitive man. The sky-high waves of the ocean must have made him feel that the sea has become monstrous. Apart from the seafood (fish) that the man might be getting at that time from the sea, he must also be crossing at times the creaks near the sea. Due to this storm in the sea, he mast have been deprived of his food and his facility of navigation must have also been

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hampered due to the surging ocean. What must have the man thought at that time? The wild fire in the jungles, which must have devastated large tracts of forest must have been another cause of fear to the primitive man. Not knowing the real cause of all these abnormal and fearful things occuring in nature, the wise people and the thinkers in the primitive people must have told others that there is some supernatural being, who has extraordinary power and strength and who is doing all these things. They must have named that being as God. The followers in the clan then must have accepted this explanation of the wise pepole of their group and must have from that time started describing God as Omnipotent, Omnipresent and Omniscient. As mankind spread in different parts of the world, they formed different groups and different nations. Some outstanding personalities then started laying foundation of their own religion in different parts of the world. Thus the different people in the world came to practice different rituals as the distinctive features of their religions; but they could never forget their original conception of God, which was inherited by them from the primitive man.

The concept of God must have taken root and developed in the human mind in some such manner as explained above; but later on a concept about the incarnations of God came into existence. Any person, who was found to possess some powers, which the other people of his time did not have, later on came to be recognised as an incarnation of God and naturally because he was the incarnation of God, all the three main qualities of God were supposed to be possessed by the incarnations of God. Thus the incarnations of God also came to be known as Omnipotent, Omnipresent and Omniscient. Shri Sai Baba is considered to be God by some devotees; but this concept of the devotees does not appear to be correct as Shri Sai Baba also Himself always said "Allah Malik" and He always said that He was a servant of the God. Jesus Christ also never said that He was God. He always used to speak about the kingdom of

God and He always told His followers that He was only an apostle of God, Mohomed Paigumber also said that "Allah" was different from Him and that the follower of Islam should pray to "Allah".

It will thus be seen that Shri Sai Baba may be called an incarnation of God. Some devotees believe that He was the incarnation of Lord Datta; but as we know He had given darshan to a doctor in the form of Shri Rama. To the Shastri from Nasik He gave darshan in the form of his Guru. Thus Shri Sai Baba appeared to His devotees in various forms and indicated that God is one though we feel that He manifests in different forms. Shri Hemadpant or Govindrao Dabholkar was acontemporary of Shri Sai Baba and he has written Shri Sai Satcharita with the blessings and consent of Shri Sai Baba. Naturally therefore we have to believe that all the incidents narrated therein are authentic and that they must have either been witnessed by Shri Annasaheb Dabholkar or heard from the persons who were concerned with those incidents. We many point out the following incidents from Sai Satcharita which show that Shri Sai Baba was Omnipotent.

- 1 Driving away the Cholera epidemic out of Shirdi by grinding wheat in a hand-mill and spreading the flour at the outskirts of Shirdi (chapter 1)
- 2 Appearing all of a sudden without anybody's knowledge under the neem tree. (chapter 4)
- 3 Streams of the rivers Ganga and Jumuna flowed from the toes of Shri Baba (chapter 4)
- 4 Shri Baba brought out a live burning coal by thrusting his prong in the ground (chapter 5)
- 5 Water started oozing when Shri Baba struck His satka on the ground (chapter 5)
- 6 Shri Baba lighted lamps with water (chapter 5)

- 7 Shri Baba took over the Bubonic plague, from which the son of Shri Dadasah eb Khaparde was suffering. (chapter 7)
- 8 Shri Baba controlled the storm and rain at Shirdi (chapter 11)
- 9 Shri Baba gave darshan to Shri Mooleyshastri from Nasik in the form of the latter's Guru Shri Gholap Swami (chapter 12)
- 10 Shri Baba gave darshan to a doctor in the form of Shree Rama (chapter 12)
- 11 Shri Baba cured Bhimaji Patil of T.B. (chapter 13)
- 12. Shri Baba cured Bala Ganpat Shimpi of Malaria by asking him to observe a recipe (Chapter 13)
- 13. Shriman Bapusaheb Booty was eured of Dysentery and vomiting by Shri Baba (Chapter 13)
- 14. Shri Booty was also cured of Cholera by Shri Baba by prescribing to him an infusion of almonds, walnuts etc (chapter 13)
- I5. Shri Baba cured a Swami from Alandi of his pain in the ear (chapter 13)
- 16. Shri Baba cured Kaka Mahajani of diarrhoea by giving him to eat a handful of ground nuts (chapter 13)
- 17, Shri Dattopant of Harda was cured by Shri Baba of his stomachache, which he had for fourteen years (chapter 13)
- Shri Baba cured Madhavrao Deshpdnde of his piles trouble (chapter 13)

19. Shri Baba cured Gangadharpant, the elder brother of Shri Kaka Mahajani of his stomach pain merely by touching his belly (chapter 13)

- 20. Intence stomach pain of Shri Nanasaheb Chandorkar was cured by Shri Baba by asking him to eat burfi (chapter 13)
- 21. Shri Ruttanji Shapurji Wadia was blessed by Shri Baba with a son (chapter 14)
- 22. Rao Bahadur Hari Vinayak Sathe was asked by Shri Baba to marry a second time and blessed him that he would get a son and accordingly he got a son from his second wife.

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- 23. Shama was cured of snake bite by Shri Baba (chapter 23)
- 24. Shri Baba gave four mangoes to Shri Damuanna Rasane and blessed him with children (chapter 25)
- 25. Though Megha poured the water of the Godawari river brought by him, on the whole body of Shri Baba, only His head was drenched and the rest of His body remained dry (chapter 28)
- 26. Shri Baba gave darshan to the chief lady of the Madrasi Bhajan mela in the form of Shree Rama (chapter 29)
- 27. Shri Baba cured a doctor's nephew from Malegaon of Tubercular bone-abcess by application of sacred Udi (chapter 34)
- 28. Shri Baba blessed a woman of Kayastha Prabhu caste from Bombay and she had painless delivery (chapter 34)

Shri Baba gave grapes to Shri Thakkar of the Solicitor's firm, Thakkar Dharamsey Jethabhai and though the first few grapes given to him had seeds, on his thinking that if Shri Baba was a saint, He should give him grapes out of the same stock without seeds, as he did not like seeds, he found that those given to him at the second time out of the same stock were entirely seedless (chapter 35)
- Mrs. Aurangabadkar got a son due to the grace of Shri Sai Baba (chapter 36)
- 31. Shri Baba averted the deaths of Ramachandra Dada and Tatya Patil (chapter 42)
- 32. Mrs. Sapatnekar got sons by the grace of Shri Sai Baba (chapter 48)
- 33. Shri Baba cured Shri Balaram Dhurandhar of his asthama trouble by giving him his clay pipe to smoke (chapter 50)

From the incidents, quoted above, it will be clear that an average man could not have achieved the things, which are mentioned therein, with the resources at his hand. However from Sai Satcharita we know that Shri Baba did all these things with ease. They are called miracles by some devotees and they are called His leelas by others; but the fact remains that unless a person had extraordinary or supernatural powers, he could not have achieved all these things. Such a person is usually described as Om nipotent i. e. having all or supreme power.

As we know Shri Sai Satcharita was composed more than sixty years before. Much water has flown dawn the Gauges during these years; but as promised by Shri Baba, He is still yery active and He is very much alive to the prayers of his devotees. He is always responding to the calls of His devotees and He is relieving them of their difficulties. This magazine, which is the authentic mouthpiece of the Shirdi Sansthan has been publishing the experiences of Shri Sai Baba's devotees, who are spread far and wide over all the continents of the world. The devotees who must be reading this magazine regularly must have noticed that the experiences narrated in the Sai Satcharita are being repeated and the devotees are experiencing the supernatural powers of Shri Sai Baba. Like the other incarnations of God, Shri Baba also is omnipotent beyond the least doubt and therefore He showers His favours on His devotees and helps them to come out of their difficulties. My wife was an expectant mother in 1943. We were then at Vizianagaram, Vishakhapatnam district, and though I had medical friends, we did not think it necessary to seek advice except for just one visit of the health visitor, who said it was all alright. We felt assured that Baba, who is ever watchful and solicitous about the welfare of His devotees, would provide the necessary help as and when required.

Towards the end of August, my wife developed labour pains. They continued in an increasing measure from day to day for 4 to 5 days. Yet, it did not strike either of us to seek medical advice. Only when delivery seemed imminent did I call a midwife. It took more than three hours of excruciating labour for a male child to be delivered.

While feeling thankful for the redress at long last, the midwife threw a bomb-shell exclaiming that there was another child in the womb. This was my wife's fourth confinement. We had not dreamt of the possibility of twins, there being no precedence on either side. We were flabbergasted. The health visitor had not said anything about twins. My wife, who was still crying and feeling exhausted with pain, became desperate and said she would not survive another delivery. The midwife after attending to the new-born child was preparing to go saying that it would not be for another six or seven hours that the second child would be born. I was completely nonplussed. There was no other help in the house except for the neighbours.

Then my wife called me and asked for Baba's Udhi. The fool that I was, I had not thought of it so far, though it was I who had narrated to her about Baba's Leela, in the case of Nanasaheb Chandorkar's daughter, how He had sent Bapu Gir with Udhi to the young woman in the throes of labour quite far away from Shirdi, which enabled her to deliver her child promptly and with ease.

With resurgent hope and courage, I forthwith gave a little Udhi to the midwife to be put in my wife's mouth as well as to be applied over the region of her womb. It was accordingly done, when lo! and behold! almost in trice, as though gently propelled by unseen hands the second of the twins was born!

What more proof could one need to demonstrate the ever loving care and immanence of Baba?

Shri Sai Baba Keeps His Word

I narrate below a true story as to how Shri Sai Baba keeps up his words "If you look to me, I look to you" for the information of all Sai devotees.

I do not exactly remember since when I have heard of Shri Sai Baba of Shirdi; but it is a fact that some time back when as usual I sat in the dispensary of Dr. Kamalakar Narwekar of Sirsi, where a big size photograph of Shri Baba was hung, I just casually read and thought of the words printed below the photograph "If you look to me, I look to you". The Doctor friend turned the topic to me and said, "Yes, they are the words of Shri Sai Baba and He keeps them up even now." It was just in my mind and whenever I saw Shri Sai Baba's photo anywhere

I remembered His words "If you look to me. I look to You." It was in 1973 February, I had gone to Bombay to buy a second hand car and I intended to buy one if I could get it upto Rs. 10,000/-. So to say ks. 10,000/- was provided for it. I with a local agent saw many cars in 5-6 days but none was for less than 12,000 to 14,00/-. I was still searching for one. Though I was tired and had given up hopes, on my way to meet the agent again, I came to Dadar and was waiting for a city bus just opposite the Sai Niketan, Dadar, Bombay, When I saw on the backside, I saw the name plate Shri Sai Baba Trust. I immediately remembered the words "If you look to me, I look to you" and before I got into the city bus, in a desperate mood, I myself started questioning Shri Sai Baba in my mind as to its correctnees. I questioned Shri Sai Baba whether He could give me a car for Rs. 10,000/ Whether He could physically come with me to the market and use His influence. Even if He does so, any body in the present day would believe Him or pay heed to His order.

Thinking these things impossible I further questioned Shri Baba as to why he said "If you look to me, I look to you" etc. I put all these questions to Shri Sai Baba in my mind and thought to myself that I will trust Him if He fulfils my desire or it is just like any layman saying so.

Just then the city bus came and I boarded it and met the agent at his place. When I went to the agent, he told me that there are 2 more company cars for sale in Worli and that we would go there. Without much hope of getting the car at my price, I went to Worli and saw the 2 cars, one fixed at 10,500/and another at 12,000/-. The quotation of 10,500,- just twisted me whether it could be Shri Sai Baba's help. I thought of buying the one fixed at 10,500/- and without seeing the Company's proprietor after confirming the price as 10,500/-, I went to a Bank to encash a bearer draft I had. Before I reached the bank, it was one hour late and casn transations were closed. To my surprise, I found a

classmate of mine working in the said bank just outside the bank premises, who helped me to cash the demand draft by using his influence in the bank. I came back with the money, went up to the office of the company with the agent and when I entered cabin of the manager, I saw a huge photograph the of Shri Sai Baba inside. I was astonished to find that Shri Baba was there inside. The Manager was so kind to me that he said that he had fixed the price as 10,500/- quite reasonably but he was so friendly to me that he himself offered to give it to me for Rs. 10,000/- as if he was giving his car to his close friend. He further started telling that the car was good & he was a devotee of Shri Sai Baba and he had come up by His grace and that is why he has named his company as Sai Baba Enterprises P. Ltd., and telegraphic address as Babakripa. I was shocked to hear these things from him as if Sai Baba replied to my earlier questions or challenge that why alone He could come with me to the mtrket, but he could give it Himself as the company was also in His name. It is at 505, Kakad Chambers 132, Dr. A. B. Rd., Worli, Bombay 18.

Can this be a coincidence? Absolutely not.

I am quite convinced from several other instances also that if one surrenders to HIM wholeheartedly, one can rest assured that Shri Sai Baba is always with him.

Shri Sai Baba's Parents

In the article "Baba And The Scriptures" (July '82) Shri Devata Subbarao has envisaged that Baba's parents are Shri Narahar Purohit and Smt. Avanthika of Patri Village in Parbhani Distrct (In that article Shri Subba Rao had stated that he learned this from an article published in Andhra Prabha dated 20-10-80)

In the episode of Shri Sai Baba Harikatha (Yekshagana) Shri Parimi Subrahmanyam has enlightened that His Brahminparents are "Hari Sade Shastry and Laxmibai of Patri village.

Shri Bapatla Hanumantha Rao has described in the life history of Shri Sai Baba (Yeme ninnupekshintuna) that He was born in the Patri village of erstwhile Nizam State to Brahmin parents and they are Jamunabai and Nandalal. This point was taken by the above author from life of Shri Sai Baba written by Rajarshi Bala Sannyasi, published by Shri Parasakti Ashram, Bangalore.

Shri P. Nageswara Kao the writer of Shri Sai Mahima and the story of Shri Swamy Keshavaiahjee, has stated that there is no evidence regarding Baba's parents. But he has stated that Baba himself told that he came from Aurangabad from the house of his uncle Shri Nasatya. The names of His parents however did not come to light.

Mani Sahukar's book "Shri Sai Baba, the Saint of Shirdi" has illustrated that there is no authentic record about Baba's birth, His parentage and the events and incidents of His childhood. As the distinguished author "Hemadpant" of Shri Sai Satcharita aptly points out that Namdev and Kabir were not born like ordinary mortals. They were discovered as infants concealed in the mother of Pearl. Namdev was found by Gonayee in the Bhima river and Kabir was found by Jamal in the Bhagirathi

river. Similarly Sai Baba was not born of mortal parents, concludes the learned author. But on one ocassion in Dhulia Magistrate's court, Baba stated that His Guru was Venkusa of Salu village and that His religion was Kabir and that his caste and creed were God. On another occasion He envisaged that His parents were Brahman and Maya and by their interlocking He got this body. Out of the Nath Panchayatan Shri Sadguru Sainath stood first and the others are Shri Madhavanath, Dhunderaj Pulsi, Shri Gajanan Maharaj and Shri Gopal Das. Another version is that out of the three perfect masters, Shri Sai Baba, Shri Mehar Baba and Shri Raghavendra Swamy (Mantralayam) Baba stood first and that He was not born to the human mortals and that He was formless and everywhere and not only in one place "Shirdi".

Each individual saw in this unique saint a personafication of his own favourite deity, an incarnation of his own chosen ideal and worshipped Him as such.

Shri Sai Baba called himself a Fakir and on His lips reverberated constantly "Allah Malik"; but as a pure Brahmin He showed a remarkable proficiency in all Yogic practices.

Whoever may be the parents of Shri Sai Baba, He is no doubt a great saint, who incarnated on this earth as Shri Sadguru Sai Baba during the 19th century to save the devotees from their sins with their sadhana and belief.

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Award of Mrs. Sushilabai Godkhindi Silver Medal, For the Year 1981

Myself and my family are an example of His glorious ways! We had no idea about Sai upto 1978 when His beloved devotee Shri B.H.Brijkishore of Hyderabad took us in His path. Shri Kishore took special interest in us and led us as a true Guru, focussing on our minds the beauty of His teachings and the fragrance of His existence through His Leelas. We are greatly indebted to our Guruji for his kindness on us. The memories of how he guided us in the devotion to Shri Sai, fill us with immense pleasure. He continues to be considerate to us even now when he has very little time for himself after attending to the large number of Sai devotees who visit him for relief from sufferings. He consoles us, shares our happiness and answers our doubts in a simple and easy way. He says, "babu! as long as we are in human flesh, we are governed by the sway of ownership- the ownership of the indrivas. We may not be capable of abdicating these to accomplish complete surrender. So we may deposit them at the feet of Shri Sai, who will safeguard them as a bank and who owes to pay to us on demand".

My devotion to Sai has passed through several milestones and has provided us insulation from worries and sufferings. We are not worried about obstacles. We are confident that Shri Sai will clear them We are not worried of difficulties. We are confident that Shri Sai will bear them. A series of such superiences of his recent Leelas, prompted me to share the pleasure of these experiences, with the other readers of Sai Leela.

During the second week of May, 1982, I visited Bangalore to attend a conference of Administrative Officers on our organisation. I was given accommodation in our organisation's guest house on the outskirts of Bangalore. Even when the tour was in the proposal stage, I planned that I should visit the Sai Spiritual Centre at Bangalore, on the day of my arrival there, before the commencement of the conference the next day. I actually arrived at Bangalore at 6.30 A.M and after reaching the guest house I left for the State Transport bus stand at 10 A.M. to board the non-stop bus for Mysore, wanting to have a look at Mysore briefly (that was my first visit there) and return to Bangalore by 5 or 6 P.M that same day so that I could visit Sai Spiritual Centre at Bangalore on the same evening. At the bus stand, I joined the long queue. At the end of the queue was the ticket counter and after purchasing the ticket, the passenger has to board the bus which waits in front of the counter. The long queue gradually drew me closer to the counter; but I feared that I may miss that bus because it was almost full and there were at least ten more passengers ahead of me. I thought for a while, if I could get that bus and leave Bangalore by 10.30, A.M. or so then I may reach Mysore early. Otherwise I may have to wait for another bus for another half an hour or so and my return journey may get delayed. Just then all the passengers ahead of me were asked to wait for the next bus because they were two families and there were only two seats vacant in the bus. I got the ticket and boarded the bus and the bus left Bangalore at 10.30 A.M. I just remembered Shri Sai for the spontaneity of His grace.

Due to His mercy, at Mysore, I could get the benefit of a guided tourist bus (which originated at Bangalore and was in the middle of its programme) and sumptuously enjoyed the beauty of that city. However, I was all the while worried that I could not fulfil my desire of visiting Sai Spiritual centre on that evening. By the time the bus reached Bangalore, it was 11 P. M.

The bus left the passengers somewhere near the Railway station. Being a complete stranger, I was worried as to how I should reach my guest house at that late hour. In front of the bus stop, I saw a small restaurant and just entered that thinking that I may first relieve my hunger. I called the bearer and was ordering the dinner. Just then, one driver of our unit at my previous place of posting appeared and expressed surprise as to how I came there. It was a real surprise for me ! He said that he came there driving the office vehicle on a field tour. After my meal, he took me to my guest house. The next morning, at 5 A.M, he picked me up from my guest house and took me to the Sai Mandir (Sai Spiritual Centre) travelling a distance of about 12 kms. We had a heartful of darshan of Shri Sai at the mandir and returned by 7.30 A.M well before the commencement of the conference at 9 A M. It was a Thursday. Shri Sai blessed me with His grace by providing me convenient transport for visiting Him. He chose to do it on a Thursday, to give it a special significance. At the Sai Mandir, Guruji spoke to me with affection and gave his blessings. I had forgotten to bring my camera from the guest house for taking photo of the Mandir. I wanted it for enabling my family to have the benefit of darshan of the mandir in the photo. So I requested Guruji whether any photographs of the mandir were available and whether I could get one or two. He thought over for a while and went inside the office room. After a while, he came out and gave me the souvenir, of the Silver Jubilee of the mandir, one book of ashtottarashatanamavali of Shri Radhakrishnaswamiji, and one book entitled : Radhakrishna Vaaksudha. I felt extremely happy to have these books. They were so precious gifts to me that I felt bewildered. Guruji said that between 6. 30 P. M and 8. 30 P. M. I might come to join the bhajan. I said that I would try. I had ltttle hope that I would be able to visit the temple again, because the distance was long and the time was too little. On the way, I went through the pages of the souvenir. Later in the evening, the driver left for his headquarters.

That whole day I was fully engrossed in the conference work. After the conference, a dinner was arranged for the participants. After the dinner, I entered my room at 9.30 P. M and opened the souvenir. The page containing the photo of the Sai Spiritual Centre opened up before me, giving me the vicarious happiness of a second visit to that Mandir. Shri Sai seemed to say that if the devotee cannot reach Him, then He Himself will appear before the devotee at his place. I felt my heart full of joy and my eyes were full of tears !

On my return journey, I came via Hyderabad. My primary duty at Hyderabad was to meet my Guruji Shri Brij Kishore. I met him at his residence on the evening of the day of my arrival. He said, "Babu! You know why the Bangalore meeting has come up ! It is to bring you here ! It is like ages since I saw you ! I am so happy !" With his blessings, I left for my place the next day.

Shri Sai has given us this life. He is leading us at all time. 'I' for us has no significance separately./ I am within Sai ! 🗶

A Legacy For Progeny

Shri Sai Baba showers His grace equally on all devotees. Shri Ramesh Mukund Rao Dharmadhikari, aged 39, is a Bank Accountant in Akola. His ancestors were all devotees of Datta and Sai Baba for the last three generations. In 1974 he was at Jalgaon when his wife, at her first delivery, was writhing in excruciating labour pains in the middle of the night. He took her to the hospital. There her pains became unbearable with each passing hour. Finally she was taken to the emergency room for what seemed an imminent ceserean operation. Greatly worried, he ran to the Balirampet Sai Baba Temple at the first break of dawn and cried like a child before Baba. The priest came over to him and learning the reason, looked at him with kind eyes. In a prophetic tone he assured him that his wife would have safe delivery without operation. He then gave Udhi and further said that a male child would be born. These soothing words came like summer showers to his parched up hopes. Recomposing his mangled nerves, he retraced his steps quickly to the hospital. There he was informed that his wife had a safe delivery half an hour back (while he was in the temple) without recourse to surgery and a male child was born.

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In December, 1980, he came to Bombay to attend a marriage. While crossing a road near Nariman Point, his wife suddenly let out a blood-curdling shriek. He turned round and saw her fixed to the ground in terror-stricken paralysis. A double-decker bus at full speed was almost on her. There was no time for action. Involuntarily he released all his lung power and yelled, "B..A..B..A." In that instant the most unbelievable happened. The double decker did a weird kind of waltzing as though it hit an invisible wall and bumped several yards back like a rubber ball. In so doing, it hit a taxi coming from

behind. It was none else but the unfailing Sai who put His giant palm to stop the onrushing monster!

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In 1981 while attending a Ganapati Festival, his motor cycle was stolen. He became nervous and a police report was lodged. A pall of gloom hung on everybody in the house-hold. For two days there was no news. Feeling like his right hand cut-off, he went into his prayer room and feelingly appealed to Baba to know what wrong he had committed. He fervently prayed for the return of the vehicle and salvage his bruised faith. In a few hours news came to him that his wehicle was found intact abandoned in a secluded place 16 miles away.

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To the discerning observer, the above incidents will confirm the belief, with clinical precision, that the grace of the Lord is such that the fruits of devotion will be available even to the progeny. Shri ai Satcharita is replete with many instances of this nature. Sai devotees, therefore, should feel greatly satisfied that after them, their legacy of devotion, the priceless grace, can be bequeathed to their heirs and to the posterity as an unfailing antidote in their difficult times.

Sainath Shows My Fault

Whenever I go to my native town-Bangalore-usually I visit Shri Sai Spiritual Centre at Thyagarajanagar and have 'darshan' of Lord Sainath to my heart's content. It is Sai who draws me to His Mandir everytime I visit Bangalore.

It so happened that I went to Bangalore on the 30th of May 1982 on my way to Coimbatore to attend a wedding and my family also accompanied me. Even though I stayed in Bangalore till the 2nd of June, somehow or the other I could not visit the Mandir. I longed very much to visit the Mandir but somehow it got postponed and ultimately we left for Coimbatore.

During our journey to Coimbatore, all along my mind was feeling guilty about not visiting the Mandir at Bangalore and on the spot I decided that I would have a darshan of Lord Sainath at Shri Nagasai Temple in Coimbatore as a priority on the 3rd June 1982.

So on the morning of 3rd June, I practically hurried to Nagasai temple along with my younger son, Master Sai Prabhu Vijaykumar. The three-year old kid was quite enthusiastic of visiting 'Sai Baba' and all along he was saying 'Baba' Baba' in his own inimitable style.

A surprise awaited me at Shri Nagasai temple

It was around about 9 a.m. when we reached the temple premises. As we washed our feet and entered the temple, an old man with white beard and wearing white dhoti and loin cloth greeted me and the first thing he asked me

"Why did you avoid me in Bangalore?"

I was surprised as I was meeting him for the first time. Even before I could reply or say something, he gave me vibhuthi and smeared a little bit on my son's forehead and in a flash, he left the place to meet other devotees. Still dazed, I went round the temple and recited 'Vishnu Sahasra Namam' and then looked around for the elderly gentleman. No! He was not to be seen anywhere in the temple premises. I was sure that it was Lord Sainath Himfelf who came in the guise of the elderly gentleman to point out my lapse of not having his darshan at Bangalore.

We returned to Bangalore after finishing the wedding at Coimbatore and had to be back at my duty on the 7th June '82. Hardly a few hours before my departure from Bangalore on the 6th night, I made a trip to Shri Sai Spiritual Centre at Thyagarajanagar, Bangalore.

Shri D. V. Krishna Murthy, the most intimate devotee of Late Shri Radhakrishna Swamiji, greeted me with his usual smile and 'Sai Ram'. There were quite a number of devotees in the hall and I joined them for recitation of 'Vishnu Sahasra Namam'.

After staying for a while, I prayed to Lord Sainath to pardon me for my lapse and shower His blessings incessantly. As I was leaving, I could overhear the conversation, a young man was having with Shri D. V. Krishna Murthy, who was quoting the 'Sai Satcharita' experience of Shri Pundalik, the Pleader, who failed to deliver the cocoanut given by Shri Vasudevanand Saraswati to Sai Baba. He was telling:-

"Don't be silly. Why do you blame yourself? It was Sainath's will. Remember everything takes place with divine drive! Keeping this ever in your mind, offer all your thoughts and acts to Sainath. Lord Sai will bless you."

This was a sermon to me also. Sainath had spoken through him. I left Bangalore with a light heart.

Shri Baba's Correct Guidance

But for Shri Baba's unfailing guidance in all important matters, the lives of Sai devotees would have been miserable. His kind care for His devotees, in all aspects of their lives, is the most precious treasure. Two incidents which took place in my life illustrate this very clearly.

In the latter half of 1978 one of my relatives brought to me a proposal of an ownership block at Borivli. He told me that the offer was at the cheapest possible rate and that block was well situated from Borivli Railway station. He further assured me that in case I needed any financial help he would give it wholeheartedly. As a B. P. T. employee I was entitled to a housing loan which would have covered 80% of cost of construction of the block, Although repayment of instalment would have been of the order of Rs. 200/- per month, still it would not have been a source of anxiety to me as I was then posted in such an office where I was getting a regular monthly additional payment of Rs. 400/- or more as overtime payment. So all these factors made my wife and myself favourably inclined towards the propsal; but as the investment was huge, it made us restless as it was a question of repayment of the housing loan over a period of 15 long years. It also meant visualising our financial situation in the next 15 years. Here lay the rub. For no human being howsoever well-placed at the present stage of his life can tell with certainty what would be his position in future. So all our thinking regarding the purchase of the block came to a halt. What to do ? We could not decide.

In these circumstances, I saw Shri Baba Dalvi my family friend and sought his help. He told me to take decision by casting lots at Sai-Niketan at Dadar. He also told me that I should do it that day itself as it happened to be the Gurupushyamruta day. I, therefore, took 1/2 day's casual leave and with my wife went to Sai-Niketan. There I cast the lots by placing two chits at the feet of Shri Baba on which was written "Block should be bought" and "Block should not be bought." A third person present picked up one chit which showed that Shri Baba's command was not to buy the block. Accordingly, I conveyed the decision to my relative, who tried to persuade me to change the decision; but he did not succeed.

Six months after the above incident, I received transfer orders from Head office to a sub-office where I had absolutely no overtime and so the additional income was cut off. Further, my relative, who had promised to help financially in case we experienced shortage of tunds because of purchase of the flat came to me to get a loan of Rs. 10,000/- for a short-term of three months. All these future events I could not have visualised; but Shri Baba had foreknowledge of these two events and accordingly He directed me well in time to drop the idea of purchasing the block and thus gave a correct decision and saved me from a financial disaster.

Another incident also took place recently. We had recently gone to holy places of Pandharpur, Ganagapur and Akkalkot. At the first halt at Pandharpur our original plan was to stay only for 2 days i.e. on 2.5.82 and 3.5.82. But suddenly my wife fellsick with diahoearrea followed by the eldest daughter, who suffered from loose motions and vomits. Thus from Sunday to Tuesday we could not move out. On Wednesday the 5th of May 1982, everything seemed fine and so I consulted my wife whether we should move out; but she said she could not decide. I, therefore, took out Shri Sai Satcharita and placed two chits at the feet of Shri Baba's photo in the book and sought Shri Baba's guidance whether we should move out or not. Shri Baba commanded "Not to move out". We accordingly did not move out. In the three hours that followed after drawing of the lots, my eldest daughter had loose motions on three occasions and she vomitted twice. My third daughter ran a high temperature and

vomitted twice. We would have run into trouble if we had not sought Shri Baba's guidance for we were to travel by bus for at least 4 hours and we could not have halted the bus on so many occasions during the journey. Shri Baba thus saved us from an avoidable inconvenience by giving us correct guidance in time.

Shri Baba's assurance to His devotees, "If You Look To Me I Look To You" thus came true to the letter. He is ever willing to help those who surrender their will to Him.

Shri Sai Never Deserts

I am an ardent devotee of Shri Sai Baba for the last about 35 years. Having read various experiences of devotees, published in Sai Leela and with a view to establish faith in Sai devotees, I am narrating this practical experience.

My wife Smt. Swarna was a sincere worshipper of Shri Sai Baba. In 1968, she was pregnent. I was transferred from Atmakur to Koilkuntla in June, 1968. On 22,12,1968, the Govt. Lady Doctor examined her and said that she was having enough of blood and as such her health was normal. She also assured me that I need not have any anxiety about her easy delivery.

On 24.12.1968, morning, the Tahsildar asked me to accompany him on camp for Land Revenue collection work. As a subordinate, I had no other alternative except to obey his orders. I came home and informed my wife, about my going on camp along with the Tahsildar. She was then entering the bath room for bath. On hearing my words, she asked me to be at home on that day without going on camp or to office. Then

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I enquired about her health. I told her that we could go either to Nandyal or Kurnool for expert treatment and safe delivery in a Jeep., if she was having any feelings of ill-health in the advanced stage of pregnency. She assured me that her health was quite good and as such the question of going elsewhere for medical treatment does not arise. I later approached the Tahsildar, and I was granted casual leave on 24-12-1968.

At about 4 P.M. on the same day, my wife Smt. swarna asked me to bring a hospital nurse to our home as she was feeling uneasy due to little of labour pains. I at once brought Laxmamma, a maternity nurse from the local hospital. She examined my wife and said that labour pains had started and that in an hour or so, the delivery would be over. The nurse asked me to get a syringe and a medicine for injection, and I did as instructed. The nurse took my wife into a room and gave her the injection. After a while, the nurse hurriedly came to me and asked me to get another medicine for giving injection to my wife to arrest bleeding. I immediately ran to the medical shop and unfortunately, the salesman was not in the shop. In anxiety, I ran hither and thither to bring the man to shop for giving the required medicine, but it was all in vain. In the meanwhile Shri R.V.Subbaiah, the Supervisor and a trusted neighbour came and informed me on the road "Sir, congratulations, you are blessed with a son. Your wife wants your immediate" presence" In joy and confusion, I hurried home and enquired" with my wife about her health. She, in a sorrowful tone said that boy was born dead. I consoled her and encouraged her, not to think of the dead baby as 1 was very much interested in: her health alone. She was lying on a cot with head towards, the west, stretching her legs towards the east. I sat by her side on the cot and with my hands on her chest, I asked her to be. brave and not to feel for the happening. She, in a hurry, asked me and pressed me to lift up my both legs and place them on,

the cot nearer to her and I did so to satisfy her wish. No sooner I placed my legs on the cot nearer to her, she, with her both hands, caught hold of my both legs and said, "I know that nothing is greater to me than yourself, my husband. Kindly excuse me for all my faults done". So saying she withdrew both of her hands from my legs. She lifted her both hands in a pose of offering 'Pranams' to elders and said, "Baba is calling me and I am going". Uttering these words she brought her lifted hands down and closed her eyes for ever. In this connection, I am to say that no photo of Shri Sai Baba or any other picture of any deity was hung on the eastern side wall, which was very clean and white. Smt. Swarna was a mother of five children with Niveditha, the last daughter aged four years of whom she was very fond. In her last moments, Swarna never cared to ask me, who was by her side alone, either to call for any children or inform me to look after them safely after her demise. She was completely free from any of the worldly . attachments by attaining complete vairagya of family bondages, except asking me, her husband, to grant pardon to her as a wife for any faults committed by her. According to Hindu philosophy the husband is the living god on earth to a devoted wife.

In her last moments my wife Swarna uttered the name of "Shri Sai Baba" and immeditely Shri Sai Baba granted her "Sakshatkara' her long felt desire. He appered before her and invited her to merge with Him. How fortunate Swarna was to see the inviting hands of Shri Sai Baba for merging in Him!

Shri Sai Baba is as powerful and affectionate to His devotees even today though He left the mortal coil in 1918. It is also most astonishing to note that Shri Sai left his body on **Tuesday** and Swarna too left her body on Tuesday 24.12.1968, to join Him and be there for ever. Shri Sai never deserts His trusted devotees and no sooner a devotee calls Him, He appears and blesses him irrespective of .time and place, provided the call is sincere and devotional.

Implicit obedience and complete surrender combined with "Nishtha and saburi" would make any devotee free from worldy anxieties and attachments.

JULY 1982

In this month the Gurupournima festival was celebrated as usual at Shirdi from 5-7-82 to 7-7-82 It is the usual practice of the devotees, going to Pandharpur for the Ashadhi Ekadashi Yatra, to visit Shirdi either before going to Pandharpur or at the time of their return journey according to their convenience. The rush of devotees, who were coming to Shirdi, was therefore quite constant in this month and the staff of the Shirdi Sansthan was therefore quite busy during the whole of this month. Due to previous experience, the Court Receiver, Shri Kakresaheb, held meetings of the departmental heads well in advance and distributed the work to them. Hence the whole festival went on smoothly without any trouble. The detailed programme of the festival was as follows :-

Monday 5-7-82 :- This was the first day of the festival, The Samadhi Mandir was opened as usual at 5 a. m. and Kakad arti was sung at 5-15 a. m. At 6 a. m. the photo of Shri Sai Baba and the pothi (Shri Sai Satcharita in Marathi) were taken in procession from the Samadhi Mandir to Dwarkamai via Gurusthan and the parayan (continuous reading of Shri Sai Satcharita) was started there. The usual programmes of holy bath, Abhishek, worship and arti went on as usual in the Samadhi Mandir at the usual timings. In the evening from 4-30 p. m. to 6-30 p. m. Shri Gangadharbuwa Vyas from Dombivli performed keertan in the Samadhi Mandir. From 7-30 p. m. to 9-00 p. m. and from 9-30 p. m. to 11-00 p. m. Shri Narayan D. Deshpande from Bombay gave a programme of his vocal music in the Samadhi Mandir. Due to melodious voice and perfect knowledge of tal etc. the programme was appreciated much by the audience. At 9-15 p. m. the procession of the Palkhi (palanquin) of Shri Sai Baba was started from Dwarkamai and it returned after 11-00 p. m. The palanquin was decorated nicely and the procession was accompanied by music and bhajan parties. After the procession returned to the Samadhi Mandir, the Shejarati was sung and the programme of the festival on the first day came to an end with the closing of the Samadhi Mandir.

Tuesday 6-7-82:- This was the principal day of the festival. The Samadhi Mandir was opened as usual at 5 a. m. and the Kakad arti was sung at 5-15 a. m. At 6 a. m. the photo of Shri Sai Baba and the pothi were brought back in procession from Dwarkamai to Samadhi Mandir via Gurusthan as the parayan started at 6 a. m. on 5-7-82 was over at 6 a. m. on this day. The usual programmes of holy bath, abhishek, worship and arti etc. took place in the Samadhi Mandir at the usual timings. From 4-30 p.m. Shri Gangadharbuwa Vyas from Dombivli performed Keertan in the Samadhi Mandir. Due to good elocution and sound knowledge of philosophy Shri Vyas kept the audience spell-bound for full two hours. The devotees were much impressed by the keertan.

The Chariot(72) of Shri Sai Baba was decorated with flowers and it was illuminated with electric lights. At 9-15 p, m, it was taken in procession from Dwarkamai through the Shirdi village. Every year the chariot is being taken in procession through the Shirdi village at the time of the festivals. Shri Sainath Madhyamick Vidyalaya Band troupe, Rahata Band troupe, Shahanai, drums, bhajan parties etc. accompanied the procession. On the return journey when the procession came to Gurusthan, the employees of the Shirdi Sansthan and the devotees from Shirdi Village sung bharud and garud for some time. In the Samadhi Mandir the programmes of the devotees were already started at 9 p. m. and they were in progress. The people, who had accompanied the procession of the chariot, .joined the audience in the Samadhi Mandir at about 12-45 a.m. (7-7-82). The programmes of the artists continued in the Samadhi mandir upto 6 a. m. on the next day i. e. 7-7-82. The Samadhi Mandir was kept open throughout the night for darshan.

Wednesday 7-7-82 :- This was the last day of the festival. As the Samadhi Mandir was kept open for the whole night, no Kakad arti was sung in the morning and the holy bath was started at 6 a. m. as usual. After that Abhishek, worship and arti programmes went on as usual in the Samadhi Mandir. From 7.30 a.m. to 8.39 a.m. Rudrabhishek was done in Gurusthan. From 11 a. m. to 12 noon, Shri Gangadharbuva Vyas performed Kala keertan in the Samadhi Mandir and after that Dahihandi programme took place. Noon arti was sung thereafter and Teerth and Prasad were distributed to the devotees who were presant for the arti. From 7.30 p. m. to 8.45 p. m. Dnyaneshwar Prasadik Bhajani Mandal, Laxmiwadi sung bhajans and from 8.45 p.m. to 10 p.m. Pimpalwadi Bhajani Mandal sung garuds and bharuds. Shejarati was sung as usual at 10 p. m. and with the closure of the Samadhi Mandir thereafter, this Gurupournima festival came to an end. For, most devotees the festival is important only upto kala Keertan and therefore many devotees leave Shirdi after the kalakeertan; which gets over at 12 noon. Other devotees, who came to Shirdi for the festival, returned home by the evening of 7-7-82 or on the morning of 8-7-82. On a moderate estimate it may be stated that over two lac devotees attended the festival.

मेरा पुत्र मध्य प्रदेश पुलिस विभाग में उपनिरीक्षक है। सन १९७९ में वह बालाघाट जिले में था। पुलिस अधीक्षक (एम. पी.) बालाघाट ने उसकी पदोन्नति के लिये सिफारिश महानिरीक्षक म. प्र. भोपाल को १९७९ में प्रेवित की थी । लेकिन उससे कनिष्ठ (Junior) तीन-चार उपनिरीक्षकों जिनको किसी मंत्री या प्रभावशाली संसद सदस्य का समर्थन (Support) था उनकी पदोन्नति की गई । परन्तु मेरे पुत्र की पदोन्नति नहीं को गई । सन १९८० में मेरे पुत्र का स्थानान्तरण (Transfer) सिवनी जिले का हो गया था। पुलिस अधीक्षक सिवनी ने उसके सर्विस रिकार्ड का निरीक्षण किया | उसकीं पदोन्नर्ति के लिये सिफारिश महानिरीक्षक म. प्र. भोपाल को १९८० में भी प्रेषित की । इसबार भी दो-तीन उपनिरीक्षक जो मेरे पुत्र से कनिष्ठ थे उनकी पदोन्नति की गई । परन्तु फिरभी इसबार मेरे पुत्र की पदोन्नति नही की गई । मेरे पुत्र को बहुत दुःख हुआ । वह इताश हो कहने लगा । मेरा कोई ठोस सपोर्ट नही है । इसलिये मेरी पदोन्नति नहीं की गई । मैं तो अब भगवान और भाग्य भरोसे हूं । जब भाग्य मे होंगा। मेरी भी पदोन्नति होगी । अपने पुत्र को इस तरह निराश देखकर मुझे अत्यन्त दु:ख हुआ । तब मैंने सद्गुरू श्री साईनाथ महाराज के चरणों की शरण में जाने का निरचय किया। मैंने साई बाबा के चरणों की पूर्ण भक्ति और अध्दा के साथ अनन्य भाव शरणागत होकर चरण बंदना की । तत्परचात् प्रार्थना की । सद्गुरु साईबाबा तू है सवँव्यापी । तु है अन्तर्यामी । तू है घट - घट में व्यापक। तू सब देखता है। सब सुनता है। सब जानता है। तेरे बच्चे के साथ जो अन्याय हो रहा है । उसकी भी तुझे पूर्ण जानकारी है । प्रभु साई बाबा मेरा तो तूही एक मात्र सहारा है। गुरुदेव तेरे चरणों के आशीर्वाद से तेरे पुत्र की पदोन्नति ३१ मार्च १९८१ पूर्व होगी । अवश्य होगी । मुझे दृढ विश्वास है । अपने सेवक दास की अन्तःकरण की प्रार्थना-पुकार स्वीकार करो साई बाबा । मेरे पुत्र की जन्म तारीख-१० मार्च है। साई बाबाने उसके पदोन्नति का आदेश उसके जन्म दिन १० मार्च को उपहार स्वरूप भेजा ! ३१ मार्च १९८१ पूर्व। पदोन्नति का आदेश प्राप्त होने पर मेरे परिवार के सदस्यों और शुभचिन्तकों को हार्दिक प्रसन्नता हुई । उसी दिन १० मार्च १९८१ को मैंने साई बाबा की पुजा आराधना की । नैवेश अपंण किया । मैंने कहा साई बाबा मैं तेरा अत्यन्त

कृतज्ञ और आभारी हूँ। तूने पुत्र की पदोन्नति ३१ मार्च १९८१ पूर्व की। मैंने परसाद पुलिय कर्मचारियों और दीगर व्यक्तियों को वितरण किया।

दयालु सर्व शक्तिमान साईबाबा समाधिस्थ होने के परचात अभी भी पूर्ववत् अपने भक्त की अन्तःकरण की सच्ची पुकार सुन सहायतार्थ तत्काल दौडकर आते है । यह मेरा दृढ विरवास है ।

शिरडी का नाम सप्ताह यज्ञ

जून, १९८२ भी श्री साई लीला (अंग्रेजी) में नाम-सप्ताह पर श्री डी. रांकरैया का लेख प्रकाशित हुआ है, जिसमें श्री साई वाबा द्वारा टास गण्रु को नाम-सप्ताह करने का आदेश और अन्तिम दिन बिठ्ठल के प्रगट होने का उल्लेख है। यह सच है कि महाराष्ट्र में सुदीर्घ काल से प्रचलित परंपरा के अनुसार बाबा नाम-सप्ताह को विशेष महत्व प्रदान करते थे। किन्तु बाबा की महा-समाधि के परचात लगभग तीस वर्ष पूर्व केवल एक बार कतिपय संन्यासियों के द्वारा नाम-सप्ताह किया गया था, जिसमें संस्थान के अधिकारियों ने भरसक सहयोग भी दिया था।

साई बाबा को भक्ति के आवरण में लौकिकता में रमने वाले एक तथाकथित संन्यासी-दंपति ने एक अन्य महिला तथा कब्र में पांव लटकाकर बैठे हुए एक वृद्ध की सहायता के इस पवित्रतम एवं लोक-कल्याणकारी आध्यात्मिक आयोजन को सफलता के परम शिखर तक जाने मार्ग में रोडा अटकाने का यथासम्भव प्रयास किया, किन्तु सार्ट को प्रिय नाम-सप्ताह आसानी के इन बाधाओं को लाँघता हुआ सफलता के परम शिखर तक पहुँचकर ही रहा ।

दिनांक १५-६-८२ को सायंकाल ६ वजे से ६॥ बजे तक साकोरी संस्थान की परम पूज्य सती गोदावरी माता ने नाम अप्ताह कार्थक्रम में पधारकर सभी भक्तों को दर्शन और आशीर्वाद दिया । साकोरी की एककन्याकुमारी ने भी हारमोनियम बजाते हुए 'ओम साई श्री साई जय जय साई' का सुललित कण्ठ से गायन किया । कॉजीपेट की श्रीमती रत्नम्मा ने भी पूज्य गोदावरी माता की उपस्थिती में गाकर लगभग १५ मिनट तक माताजी तथा अन्य भक्तों को मन्त्र-मुग्ध कर दिया ।

बाबा की कृपा सचमुच अपरंपार है। वे अपने भक्तों पर सदा नजर रखकें होते है। वे उनका किसी भी प्रकार का अहित नहीं होने देते। हाल ही मैं उनकी दोहरी कृपा का एहसास मुझे एक बार पुनः हुआ।

कई बार वह दृश्य भुलने की कोशिश करता हूँ। फिर मी आँखों के सामने आ ही जाता है। घटना विदिशा जिले के एक छोटे से गाँव की है। उस गाँव में जनता दरवार लगता था। अर्थात कलेक्टर महोदय जनषमस्याओं का निराकरण जहाँके तहाँ (ऑन द स्पॉट) करने वाले थे । शासकीय एवं संस्थागत विभागों के प्रतिनिधियों को बहाँ पर उपस्थित होना था। अग्रणी बैंकमें होने के नाते हमारें साहब भी वहाँ पर जा रहे थें । मैं भी सहयोगी अधिकारी के नाते उनके साथ था। मुझे विभाग से सम्बन्धित अन्य कार्य भी करना था। गाँव की दूरी जीप के हिसाब से दो घंटे की थी। प्रातः ५ बजे निकलकर ७ बजे तक वहाँ पहुंचना जरूरी था । मुहिकल से आधा घंटा सफर तय हुआ था कि जीप का होस पाईप फट गया । स्पेयर होस पाईप लगाने के बावजूद भी लीकेज जारी रहा । रास्ते में पडने वाली हर नदी पर पानी लेते लेतें अखिर ९ बजे तक इम वहाँ पर पहुंच गये । बाबा की कुपा से अभी दरबार चालू नहीं हुआ था । लगभग १० बजे जनता दरबार प्रारंभ हुआ । गाँव वाले अपनी समस्या कलेक्टर महोदय के सामने रखते, और संभव होने पर उनका निराकरण उसी समय कर दिया जाता । कुछ समय पर्चात मैंने साहब से निकटतम गाँव में जाने के लिये इजाजत ली । वहाँ से कुछ जानकारी एकत्रित की जाना थी । दो घंटे में वापस आने को साहब ने कहा। सभी परिस्थितियाँ सामान्य होने पर दो घंटे में वापस आना संभव था। ३००-४०० व्यक्तियों का वह जनता दरबार छोडकर इम मंझिल की और चल पडे । हमारे चालक महोदय एक्स सर्विसमेन थे। अतःगाडी पर उनका अच्छा कमांड था। हम भी उनकी और से निश्चिन्त थे। मुश्किल से पॉच मिनिट गाडी चली होंगी और यह घटना हो गई । एक नदी पार की जाना थी । नदी में पानी नहीं के बराबर था अत: धीरे से नदी पार कर ली गई। अब गाडी दूसरी और के चढाव पर चढ रही थी। । मैं कुछ सोच ही रहा था कि अचानक गाडी

खडी हो गई ! धीरे धीरे गाडी से मैं उतरा । चालक ने भी मेरा अनुकरण किया । गाडी से उतरकर जो दृश्य मैंने देखा वह सचमुच शरीर पर रोंगटे खडे कर देने वाला था । गाडी आधा हिस्सा पन्द्रह फिट के एक गडड़े में झुका हुआ था । यदि एक बडे पत्थर के सहारे जीप नहीं टिकती तो न जाने क्या होता । दरअसल उस स्थान पर एक खतरनाक मोड था । एक पल चालक की नजर स्टियरींग व्हील से इटने का परिणाम सामने था । उस चालक की जिंदगी में यह पहली गल्ती थी ।

गाडी अब घीरें घीरे गड्डे की और झुकी जा रही थी । इस बिकट परिस्थित से उभरने के लिये आवश्यकता थी। २०-२५ आदमीयों की, अच्छी मोटी रस्सी की और कुछ बल्लियों की जरूरत थी । दूसरे यह काम बिना शोर मचाये किया जाना था । क्योंको करीब ही चल रहा था जनता दरबार जहाँ कलेक्टर महोदय गाँववालों की समस्याओं को सुलझा रहे थें। जहाँ एक आंर यदि किसी के कानों में इस घटना की भनक पडने से जनता दरबार में खलबली मच जाना स्वाभाविक था, वहीं दूसरी ओर २०-२५ आदमीयें। को बिना शोर मचाये इकळा करना बडा कठिन कार्यथा । बाबा ने कुछ समय पूर्वपाणों की रक्षा तो की ही थी। फिर भी इस समय उनके आर्शिवाद की पुन: आवश्यकता थी। बाबा का नाम ळेकर हमने जीप को गड्डे से निकालने के उस चुनौतीभरे अभियान का प्रारंभ किया । जनता दरवार में अन्य विभागों के प्रतिनिधी भी अपनी अपनी गाडियाँ लेकर आये थें। प्रतिनिधीवर्ग दरबार में व्यस्त था, तो उनकी गाडियों के चालक एक स्थान पर गपशप कर रहे थे। हमने घटना की जानकारी सर्वप्रथम उन्हें देकर चिन्ता प्रकट की | उन्होंने कहा, 'आप जरा भी चिन्ता न करें, हम सब आपके साथ है।" फिर उनके सहयोग से गांव के दो-चार चौकीदार इकडे किये। गाँव के पटेल ने रस्सीयाँ, बल्लीयाँ आदि सामान जुटाया । प्रक्रिया बडी धीमी गति से चल रहीं थी। गाडी गड्डें से निकलने में अधिक समय लगेगा इसीलीये कोई तैयार नही था । चार आदमीयों को इकठ्ठा करके घटनास्थल पर ले जाओं और अन्य व्यक्तियों को बुलाने का प्रयास करो तब तक पहले वाले आदमी नदारद। शोर करना होता तो २५ के स्थान पर १०० आदमी इकट्ठे हो जाते । अंततः एक घंटे के अथक प्रयत्नों से २०-२५ आदमीयों को घटनास्थल पर बिना शोर किये इकठ्ठा करने में कामयाबी मिली । अब तक कुछ बच्चों को जीप गड्डे में गिरने

की जानकारी मिल चुकी थी। अतः इसकी भनक इमारें साहब के कानों पर भी पड गई। फिर भी हमने ''गाडी किचड में फंसी है, आठ-दस आदमीयों के धक्का लगाने से निकल जायेंगी'' कहकर उनके घटनास्थल की ओर चलने के आग्रह को टाल दिया।

बाबा के आशिर्वाद से गाडी गड्ड से बाहर निकालने में अधिक कठिनाई नहीं हुई । गाडी में एक पैसे का नुकसान भी नहीं हुआ था । उपस्थित जनअमुदाय का हमारें प्रति यही मत था ''ना जाने किस जन्म का पुण्य काम आया जो आप वच गयें.....' मैंने उनसे कहा यह सब बाबा की कृपा है। सचमुच उनकी महिमा अपरंपार है।

जनता दरबार अब भी शांतिपूर्वक चल रहा था । ग्रामवासी अपनी अपनी समस्याओं को कलेक्टर महोदय के सामने रख रहे थें और वे उसका निराकरण करने में व्यस्त थें । हमारी समस्या का निराकरण वावा ने किस तरकीव से किया, इसका अंदाजा आप स्वंय लगासकते है। वाबा की दोहरी क़ुपा ने एक वार मुझे पुनः इस बात का एहसास करा दिया कि श्रध्दा और सबूरी रखने से उनका

साया इमेशा भक्तों के साथ रहता है। बाबा के चरणों में एक बार पुनः वंदन.....
