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

SIGNIFICANCE OF SHRI RAM NAVAMI




In Shrimad Ramayan, Ravan represents the Prince of Darkness, while Shri Ram represents the Prince of Light. In respect of character they are, as is to be expected, poles assunder.

Shri Ram is the very embodiment of Dharma, while Ravan is Adharma in flesh and blood. The one would not hesitate to make any sacrifice to uphold the cause of Dharma, while the other would light-heartedly violate every canon of decency to gratify his lust and vanity.

Shri Ram's sole interest in life was to set lofty standards of conduct for others to follow, while the chief aim of Ravan was to aggrandize and bend others to his will by show of physical might. Shri Ram's path was the steep and thorny one of self-denial and renunciation, while Ravan's path was the primrose leading to eternal damnation. The contrast between these two leading figures of Shrimad Ramayan is as sharp and striking as any in history or fiction.


Shri Ram's heroic qualities are set forth in Narad's reply to poet Valmiki. They are numerous and rare. Shri Ram can speak the truth and yet be nice and pleasant; he can be firm and unyielding without appearing to be a stickler; he can be kind without being sentimental or soft; he can be brave without being a bragger; he can be correct and even meticulous in his conduct without giving an impression of





being inhuman. When he is angered, not even the Gods can stand against him. But, by his nature he was patient and gentle.

Only truly great men can strike the mean between opposites and bring them into harmony. It is the living spirit that reconciles all contradictions. Valmiki's conception of Shri Ram is that of the hero as the perfect man. He is great in war and equally great in peace; he is a soldier, as well as a statesman; he is learned in the shastras and equally well practiced in arms. He could shine in any company. He punished evil doers and rewarded the virtuous. His anger and his sympathy always meant



something. Just as his arrows were never shot in vain, even so his words never failed of their purpose. He never equivocated. He meant what he said.

Such is the picture of the great hero that poet Valmiki has drawn for the benefit of the generation of men to follow and to emulate. As one reads and re-reads it, laying himself open all the time to its sweet and mellowing influence, one's inner nature undergoes a silent change, sometimes even revolution, and he acquires a new dimension of being, namely, spiritual. He attains new altitudes of greatness, new and unsuspected heights of heroism. It is hardly possible to exaggerate the importance of the Ramayan as a force which makes for righteousness. It breathes *Dharma* everywhere and the readers cannot but imbibe this wholesome influence.


If the masses of the Indian people, in spite of their illiteracy and grinding poverty, are still peaceful and law-abiding, their behaviour is due to a large measure to the influence exerted on them by the popular exposition of the Ramayan through the



ages.

We now come to the other point of view, namely, the religious. According to this view, Shri Ram is God descended on earth, an *Avatar* of Lord Shri Hari. The object of the descent is to punish the wicked and restore the eternal *Dharma* to its rightful place of pre-eminence. God is therefore the ultimate guarantor of *Dharma*. By listening to the stories of his mighty achievements in putting down the forces of evil, we acquire religious merit and qualify ourselves eventually for Liberation. The pious reading of the Ramayan is therefore enjoined as a religious exercise on the devotees.

Ramayan presents two views. One - the possibility of the ascent of man to divinity, and the second - the descent of God to the world of human beings. The author blends in a happy way the above ideas - that God fulfils himself in the ideal man Shri Ramchandra, and that man, as king Dasharatha's son, rises to his full stature by pulling up his manhood to the



level of Brahmahood. According to both views there is the meeting of the Human and the Divine in Shrimad Ramayan which Sage Valmiki has bequeathed to the world.

In remembrance of such a noble *Avatar* like Shri Ramchandra, Shri Sai Baba, himself lit the lights with water instead of oil and celebrated Shri Ram Navami at Shirdi by setting up the path of righteousness for us to follow.

Oh! Devotees of Baba, I am sure you are very well aware of this great incident which has created a stir in the hearts of all of us to remember Baba Sai as 'RAM' himself in guise to bless the humanity to refresh themselves once again to set our steps on the right path to preserve *Dharma* at all costs. The rejoicing at Shirdi and at all centres of our country on this Ram Navami day will never be forgotten.

May 'Shri Sai Ram', the Spirit of Truth and Love in the form of *Dharma*, be invoked on this Auspicious day to bless the humanity with peace, good will and prosperity on earth at all times.



Shri Ram Navami Festival – 2022

he Ram Navami festival was started in Shirdi in 1911 with the permission of Shri Sai Baba. Since then this festival is celebrated every year in Shirdi with great enthusiasm. Sai devotees from all over the country and abroad come to Shirdi for this festival. But, the last two vears the Shri Sai Samadhi Mandir was closed for the darshan by the the devout-devotees due to the corona-virus crisis from March 17, 2020. But, all the daily religious programmes of the temple continued as usual. During the intervening period, of 2020 and 2021, the Shri Ram Navami, taking into account the tradition of the Ram Navami festival, to avoid the discontinuation of the religious programmes in the temple during the festival period, all programmes were conducted with the participation of the officers and employees of the Sansthan, without the devout-devotees, in a modest way.

But, with the spread of the corona-virus under control, the Shri Ram Navami festival was held by the Shri Saibaba Sansthan Trust, Shirdi this year from Saturday, April 9, 2022 to Monday, April 11, 2022 in Shirdi with great pomp. The festival commenced in an air of piety. The whole of Shirdi resounded with the chants of Shri Sai Baba's name by the

padayatris (pilgrims on foot) accompanying the Sai palkhis (palanquins) who came for the darshan of Shri Sai Baba's Samadhi from all over Maharashtra. They were welcomed on behalf of the Sansthan. For this, a pandal was erected in the area adjacent to the Shirdi Police Station and Shirdi Nagar Panchayat and two priests and two chopdars were appointed there.

Well planned arrangements were made to facilitate easy and convenient darshan for the devotees during the festival. Cloth mandaps were erected in the temple premises to provide shade from the heat. Along with security guards, water and electricity facilities were also provided. Drinking water was provided at various places along the darshan queue. Pandals were erected at Sai Baba Bhakta Niwas-sthan (500 rooms) and Sai Dharma Shala for the additional accommodation of Sai devotees. Also, to ensure proper shelter facility, cloth mandaps with beddings were erected, by the Sansthan, at various places on the Mumbai - Shirdi route for the pilgrims on foot (padayatris) accompanying the palkhis (palanguins). Water and electric supply were provided in the mandaps. Mobile medical squad was kept in service on the route to ensure instant medical care to the padayatris. And, first aid





centers were started at the Dixit wada opposite to Gurusthan, darshan queue, 500-rooms new Bhakta Niwas-sthan, Sai Ashram, Shri Sai Prasadalaya, Shri Sai Baba Samadhi Mandir Shatabdi Mandap near Maruti Mandir and other places. Similarly, accommodation was arranged in the Sai Dharmashala for the padayatris at nominal charges after they reached Shirdi. Laddu prasad packets were made available at the gate number 5, Shri Sai Mangal Karyalaya, open drama theatre opposite to Dwarkamai, Sai Complex near Maruti Mandir, Shri Sai Prasadalaya and all other accommodation places for Sai devotees during the festival period.

Kakad Aarati was done at 5.15 a.m, early morning on the first day of the festival on Saturday, April 9, 2022. After the Kakad Aarati, a grand procession of Shri Sai Baba's Photo, the holy Grantha 'Shri Sai Satcharita' and the Veena with the playing of musical instruments was taken from Shri Sai Samadhi Mandir to Dwarkamai via Gurusthan. Chairman of the Sansthan Shri Ashutosh Kale with the holy Grantha 'Shri Sai Satcharita', Vice Chairman Adv. Jagdish Sawant and Trustee Adv. Suhas Aher with the Photo of Shri Sai Baba and the Trustee Shri Avinash Dandwate with the Veena participated in the procession. The trustees, Shri Sachin Gujar, Shri Rrahul Kanal, Shri Suresh Wabale, Shri Mahendra Shelke, Dr.



Eknath Gondkar, then Deputy Chief Executive Officer incharge Shri Babasaheb Shinde, Security Officer Shri Annasaheb Pardeshi, Chief of the Temple dept. Shri Ramesh Chaudhari, Temple priests, villagers and Sai devotees were present in large numbers on the occasion. After the procession reached Dwarkamai, "Shirdi majhe Pandharpur" Aarati was performed by worshiping the holy Grantha 'Shri Sai Satcharita', the Veena and the Photo of Shri Sai Baba there. After that at 6.20 a.m. the Akhand (non-stop) Parayan (reading) of the holy Grantha 'Shri Sai Satcharita' commenced. Chairman of the Sansthan Shri Ashutosh Kale read the first chapter, Sou. Shobhatai Gondkar read the second, Trustee Shri Sachin Gujar read the third, Sou. Surekhatai Shelke read the fourth and Miss Avantika Dandwate read the fifth chapter. After the Shri Sai's holy bath at 6.35 a.m. the darshan for Sai devotees commenced. At 7 a.m. "Shirdi majhe Pandharpur" Aarati was





done.

At 7.10 a.m. the Sansthan's Chairman Shri Ashutosh Kale along with his wife Sou. Chaitalitai Kale performed the ritual worship of Shri Sai Baba's Feet (Padya Pooja) in the Samadhi Mandir. Trustees, Shri Rrahul Kanal, Shri Suresh Wabale, Shri Mahendra Shelke, Dr. Eknath Gondkar, then Deputy Chief Executive Officer incharge Shri Babasaheb Shinde, Security Officer Shri Annasaheb Pardeshi, Head of the Temple dept. Shri Ramesh Chaudhari and Temple priests were present on the occasion. At 7.30 a.m. Abhishek Pooja was done on the Samadhi of Shri Sai Baba for the welfare of the society.

At 12.30 p.m., the Mid-day *Aarati* was done. Shri Niraj Dhote, Principal Secretary, Law and

Justice dept., Maharashtra State, attended the *Madhyan Aarati*. Smt. Bhagyashree Banayat, Chief Executive Officer of the Sansthan and Vice Chairman Adv. Jagdish Sawant were present on the occasion. At 4 p.m. melodious *kirtan* programme by *H.B.P.* (Hari Bhakta Parayan) Shri Vikram Nandedkar was held on the dais beside the Samadhi Mandir.

At 6 p.m. the Sansthan's Trustee Adv. Suhas Aher along with his wife Sou. Smitatai Aher performed the ritual worship of Shri Sai Baba's Feet (Padya Pooja) in the Samadhi Mandir.

At 6.30 p.m. the *Dhoop Aarati* was done. Shri Ninad Group - Mrs. Padyavati Parekar, Pune presented a devotional music programme on the stage in the Shri Sai Baba Samadhi Mandir Centenary pandal from 7.30 p.m. to 9.50 p.m. Artists took part in the programme were felicitated on behalf of the Sansthan with 3-D calendar, Shri Sai Satcharita, shawl - Shreephal and laddu prasad packet. At 9.15 p.m., a procession of Shri Sai Baba's Palanquin was taken out with the playing of musical instruments through the Shirdi village. Villagers and Sai devotees were present in large numbers on the occasion. In front of the Palanquin, Temple priest Shri Ulhas Walunjkar, Shri Gaikwad, Shri Vaidya and other artists presented the programme of bharuds. Dwarkamai was kept





open overnight for the Akhand Parayan of the holy Grantha 'Shri Sai Satcharita'.

Sunday, April 10, 2022, the main day of the festival, Kakad Aarati of Shri Sai Baba was done at 5.45 a.m. After the Kakad Aarati, the Akhand Parayan was completed. The procession, with the playing of musical instruments, of the Photo of Shri Sai Baba, 'Shri Sai Satcharita' Grantha and the Veena from Dwarkamai to Shri Sai Samadhi Mandir via Gurusthan was taken out. The Sansthan's Trustee Shri Suresh Wabale with the Veena, Trustees, Shri Sachin Gujar and Shri Mahendra Shelke with the Photo of Shri Sai Baba, Trustee Hon'ble Anuradha Adik with the holy Grantha 'Shri Sai Satcharita' participated in the procession. Vice Chairman of the Sansthan Adv. Jagdish Sawant, Trustees, Adv. Suhas Aher, Shri Rrahul Kanal, Shri Avinash Dandwate, Shri



Jaywantrao Jadhav, Dr. Eknath Gondkar, then Deputy Chief Executive Officer incharge Shri Babasaheb Shinde, Administrative Officers, Dr. Akash Kisave and Shri Dilip Ugale, Security Officer Shri Annasaheb Pardeshi, Chief of the Temple dept. Shri Ramesh Chaudhari, Temple priests, villagers and Sai devotees were present on the occasion. After the procession returned to the Samadhi Mandir, "Shirdi majhe Pandharpur" Aarati was done At 6.35 a.m. and the Akhand Parayan of the holy Grantha 'Shri Sai Satcharita' was concluded. At 6.45 a.m. the Sansthan's Vice Chairman Adv. Jagdish Sawant and the Trustee Hon'ble Anuradha Adik and Sou. Shobhatai Gondkar performed the worship of the Kavadi (temple flag-post). The first five *kavadi* holders were felicitated in a representative manner. Shri's five-metal idol was placed in front of the palanguin entrance





on the south side of the temple to carry the water to the devotees. After that, the Shri's holy bath was done and "Shirdi *majhe* Pandharpur" *Aarati* was performed. The worship of the holy Feet of Shri Sai Baba was done by the Vice Chairman of the Sansthan Adv. Jagdish Sawant along with his wife Sou. Janhavitai Sawant in the *Samadhi Mandir*.

At 9 a.m. the worship of the sack of wheat from Dwarkamai was done in the *Samadhi Mandir* and the worship of the Flag of the Shri Sai Baba *Samadhi* Centenary Pillar at Lendibaug was performed by the Chairman of the Sansthan Shri Ashutosh Kale. Chief Executive Officer of the Sansthan Smt. Bhagyashree Banayat, Vice Chairman Adv. Jagdish Sawant, Trustees, Adv. Suhas Aher, Shri Avinash Dandwate, Shri Sachin Gujar, Shri Rrahul Kanal, Shri

Suresh Wabale, Shri Jaywantrao Jadhav, Shri Mahendra Shelke, Dr. Eknath Gondkar, then Deputy Chief Executive Officer incharge Shri Babasaheb Shinde and Chief of the Temple dept. Shri Ramesh Chaudhari were present on the occasion. *H.B.P.* Shri Vikram Nandedkar presented *kirtan* on the birth of Shri Ram at 10 a.m.

After the *kirtan*, the Shri Ramjanmotsav was performed by the Chief Executive Officer of the Sansthan Smt. Bhagyashree Banayat.

Prior to the Noon *Aarati*, the ritual worship of the new flags was done by the Rasane and Deshpande (Nimonkar) families and a procession of the flags was taken out at 4 p.m via *palkhi* route. After the procession, the flags were hoisted at Dwarkamai by Shri Rasane and Shri Nimonkar families.







At 5 p.m. the procession, with the playing of musical instruments, of Shri Sai Baba's Chariot was taken out through the Shirdi village. Sai devotees and villagers participated in this in large numbers. In front of the Chariot, Temple priest Shri Ulhas Walunjkar, Shri Gaikwad, Shri Vaidya and other artists presented the programme of bharuds. At 5.45 p.m. the worship of the holy Feet of Shri Sai Baba was done by the Sansthan's Trustee Shri Avinash Dandwate along with his wife Sou. Rashmitai Dandwate in the Samadhi Mandir. At 8.10 p.m. Shri's Dhoop Aarati was done after the return of Chariot procession in the Samadhi Mandir. Shri Vijay Sakharkar, Mumbai presented a programme from 7.30 p.m. to 10 p.m. on the stage in the Shri Sai Baba Samadhi Mandir Centenary pandal. Artists took part in the programme were felicitated on behalf of the Sansthan with 3-D calendar, Shri Sai Satcharita, shawl - Shreephal and laddu prasad packet. At 9 p.m. the Sandal procession was taken out from the late Abdul Baba's hut. Traditional rituals were performed by placing the Sandal in Dwarkamai.



After that, the Shri's tomb was pasted with sandalwood and red-green cloth was offered. Artists presented programmes on that day from 10 p.m. to the next day till 5 a.m. on the dais beside the *Samadhi Mandir*. Being the main day of the festival, the *Samadhi Mandir* was kept open for the *darshan* throughout the night. Therefore, several devotees could avail the *darshan* of Shri Sai Baba's *Samadhi*.

At 5.05 a.m. on Monday, April 11, 2022, the concluding day of the festival, Shri's holy bath was done. At 5.45 a.m. "Shirdi *majhe* Pandharpur" *Aarati* was done. The Sansthan's trustee Hon'ble Anuradha Adik along with her family performed the worship of the Feet of Shri Sai Baba in the *Samadhi Mandir* at 7.15 a.m. The Sansthan's Chief Executive Officer Smt. Museum and Meditation Hall Open...

Smt. Bhagyashree Banayat, Chief Executive Officer of the Shri Saibaba Sansthan Trust, Shirdi, informed that the Sansthan's Shri Sai Baba Museum and the Meditation Hall have been opened for the devout-devotees from Tuesday, February 15, 2022 between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m.

Smt. Banayat stated that "the museum having been established at Dikshit wada in the Shri Sai Samadhi Mandir premises to inform Sai devotees about the things used by Shri Sai Baba, like the footwear, kafni (long robe), chillum (traditional smoking pipe made of clay), pillow, mattress, chariot, palanquin, cot and many such things along with their information have been placed for darshan here. Also, a new meditation hall has been prepared on the first floor of Shri Sai Satyavrat Hall by the Sansthan to facilitate meditation, sadhana and remembering the Lord's name by the devout coming for Shri Sai Baba's darshan. About 250 to 300 devotees come here everyday to meditate. But, in the last two years, due to the corona virus crisis worldwide and in the country, the Samadhi Mandir of Shri Sai Baba was closed for the darshan to the devout-devotees of Shri Sai Baba on Tuesday, March 17, 2020. In these two years, the State Government had declared a lockdown twice due to the corona virus crisis. After that, when the temple of Shri Sai Baba was opened for the darshan to the devoutdevotees, then the Shri Sai Baba Samadhi, Dwarkamai, Gurusthan, Village Deity Ganapati, Shanidev, Mahadev, Shri Datta in Lendi Baug and Nandadeep having been opened for the darshan, arrangement for the darshan was made for the devout-devotees only in a single line. But, the meditation hall and the Shri Sai Baba Museum was not opened for the devout-devotees. However, demands to open the Museum and Meditation Hall were being made by the Sai devotees and villagers consistently.

As per the demand of the Sai devotees and villagers the Sansthan has opened the Shri Sai Baba Museum and Meditation Hall for the devout-devotees from Tuesday, February 15, 2022 between 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. The devout-devotees having been given entry to both these places after the darshan of Shri Sai Baba's Samadhi as per the corona norms, it is mandatory for the devout-devotees to maintain social distancing, use sanitizers and wear masks as per the COVID rules. Similarly, after being allowed entry to the Meditation Hall, the devout-devotees can meditate for 10 to 15 minutes. Along with this the devout-devotees are not allowed to do the reading or parayan of the holy book in the Meditation Hall, all devoutdevotees and villagers take note of this.'

And, strictly following all the guiding norms concerning COVID 19, the devout should avail the benefit of the Shri Sai Baba Museum and Meditation Hall, stating so, Smt. Bhagyashree Banayat appealed to all devout-devotees and villagers to co-operate with the Sansthan.

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Change in Timing of Kelted Aereti and Shej Aereti...

The Managing Committee of the Shri Saibaba Sansthan Trust, Shirdi, having decided at its recently held meeting to do the *Kakad Aarati* of Shri Sai Baba at 5.15 a.m. and the *Shej Aarati* at 10 p.m. as earlier, its implementation began on Tuesday, March 1, 2022 on the occasion of *Maha Shivratri*.

Various worship-offerings are done in the Shri Sai Baba Samadhi Mandir regularly as per tradition. After the *Shej Aarati* at 10 p.m. the *Samadhi Mandir* will be closed at 10.45 p.m.

Considering the constant demand of the Sai devotees and villagers, entry was given to the devout-devotees and villagers for the *Kakad Aarati* at 5.15 a.m. and *Shej Aarati* at 10 p.m. from March 1, 2022.

Corona Vaccination for Children Aged 12 to 14


